ACADEMIC

The academic year begins in April and Ends in march every Year. School calendar year is from July to June.

Normaly only those children who are over two and half and below three and half years of age will be admitted in the nursery Class. A corresponding age limit is set for the next classes.

Except beginners, students seeking admission for higher classes must pass oral/ written test in the core subject. If a student has attended any other school he must produce a Transfer Certificate from that school.

The principal reserves the right of retaining students whose attendance is irregular progress in studies unsatisfactory, conduct harmful to others, full participations in co-curricular activities lacking or whose fees are not paid in time. Honesty, cleanliness of persons and dress, good manners and loyalty are demanded of each student. Any one not conforming to the school, ideals in these matters may, after due notice to his parents be asked to leave. Immorality, grave in subordination and contempt of authority are always sufficient reasons for dismissal

The parents / guardians are hereby informed that their sons/wards after passing class X. Boards examination should fill up a new admission form for further studies at plus two stage.

The applicants should apply in the prescribed admission form attached in the school Prospectus.

The Prospectus for admission to class XI will be available at school office immediately after the declaration of Boards result.

NOTE: 1) In granting admission, besides the academic performance, the conduct of the candidate will also be taken into account.

2) Only the selected candidates should deposit the fees in the school office.

EXAMINATION:

1) There will be two examinations in the course of the year at regular intervals.

TERM-I : April to September

TERM –II : October to March

2 formative test in term-I in May & August 2formative test in term-II in November & January Class X & XII pre Boards in January Class IX & X Practicals during February Class XII Practicals during February 1st Week.

- Students absent from the examination for any reason are not re-examined in any case, except in Annual Examination.
- The results of the examinations are final and will not be reconsidered.
- The minimum marks required for passing for each subject shall be 35%.

PROMOTION:

Promotion for the students from classes LKG to X is granted on the basis of the quality of regular and satisfactory work done during the whole year (C.C.E) . Hence marks abtained in the examinations are added together to decide promotions. The Principal / Authorised signatory is the final judge of a student's fitness for promotion.
